DESCRIPTION

Learn how to make a rockin' paperweight with Scott Sicari. All you need is some paint and a rock to make this project.

MATERIALS

- clean, flat rock
- acrylic paints
- paintbrush
- glue
- yarn
- plastic plate
- scissors
- paper for work surface

DIRECTIONS

1. Coat the top and sides of a clean flat rock with paint that matches your loved one's skin tone. You can go to a park or your backyard to find a rock, but if you're having trouble finding one, you can always get a rock at your local craft store. When you're done painting, let your rock dry for 30 minutes.
2. Add yarn for the hair. You should use whatever color yarn that matches your loved ones hair! Glue the yarn on in clusters.
3. Paint on your loved one's eyes, nose, mouth, and any other distinguishing features they have.
4. Let your paper weight dry for an hour and then it's ready to present to the one you love!
