



PAPER AIRPLANES

TWO PIECE JET

DESCRIPTION

The most amazing thing about making this paper airplane is that you only need TWO sheets of paper to start having fun! Join in on the action and fold along with paper airplane sage, Michael LaFosse...you'll be zooming into action in no time!

MATERIALS

- 6 inch or smaller square sheet of paper, color side-up (both should be the same size)

DIRECTIONS

1. Have both pieces of paper in front of you, color side up.
2. Fold the bottom to top corners in half.
3. Flip so the long edge of triangle is on top.
4. Fold top right layer towards the top edge.
5. Flip paper over and repeat with left side. Bottom edge goes to top.
6. Open each paper and decide which is the front and back of plane.
7. Front: Flip and take bottom corner and fold to top.
8. Body: Flip and unfold paper completely. Fit paper at crease point (the nose) of the other paper.
9. Turn paper, so long edge is on top.
10. Roll top layer to top edge and fold, making the nose. Repeat on the other side.
11. Turn paper over and fold wings so that they stand in a "Y" shape.
