PEANUT BUTTER BALLS

DESCRIPTION

Peanut butter balls can't be beat and are a perfect after school or summertime treat. So join Chef Ralph Pallarino and learn how to make this awesome snack!

INGREDIENTS

- 1 1/2 cups peanut butter, Skippy or equivalent, not natural peanut butter
- 3 and 1/4 cups of powdered sugar
- 1/2 cup butter, softened
- 1 tsp. vanilla
- 1 package chocolate chips
- shredded coconut

TOOLS

- electric mixer
- bowl
- serving plate

DIRECTIONS

1. Mix peanut butter, butter and vanilla with an electric mixer until well blended.
2. Add the powdered sugar, a little at a time, blending with the mixer until all the sugar is mixed in. The dough will be slightly crumbly when all the sugar is added. Then add the chocolate chips and mix the dough up by hand.
3. Form the dough into 1 - 1 1/2 inch size balls by rolling the dough between your hands. Roll each ball in coconut then set formed balls on a plate for serving, and they are ready to eat!
